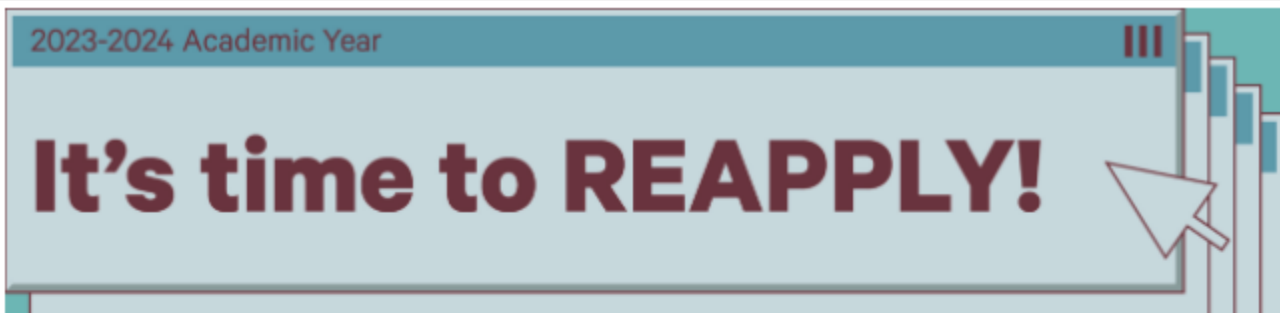

2) It starts with a brief welcome message and explanation of next steps for selecting / changing your room!

As you work your way through the application, you'll click the **NEXT STEP** buttons at the bottom of each page. Please work your way all the way through the application, through your preferences, and through the step where it tells you that your deposit is already paid.

Then, you'll see a **FINISH** button which means you've made it to the end!

Step 1 - Apply today! Sign your terms & conditions, and complete your application.

Step 2- Select your room before March 31, 2023. You immediately have the ability to select the room you want to live in next year. (This is encouraged for everybody not currently in the apartments.) You can select rooms on returner / upper-class / LLC floors (if you are eligible).

Interested in an apartment? Students living in the residence halls are still encouraged to select a room; this will not effect your chances at getting assigned to an apartment. Apartment assignments are made by Residence Life in February 2023.

Step 3- Receive information about your room assignment / more information.

Current apartment residents are guaranteed an apartment if they apply by January 31, 2023. Assignments for all remaining apartments spaces are made based on application completion date & time. Anyone who has not selected their room by March 31 will have their room assignment selected for them.

Step 4- Change your room assignment until July 15! We give you the flexibility to change your assignment for any reason; you'll be able to see all available spaces you are eligible for.

MealPlan: Dining Dollars:

You will receive Dining Dollars at the beginning of each the Fall and Spring semesters. Unused dining dollars from Fall 2023 will roll-over to Spring 2024, but any unused dining dollars at the end of Spring 2024 expire. Your meals-per-week Meal Plan resets every Monday.

The most popular choices are the 14-meal plan and \$200 dining dollar package. Please note: meal plans may only be decreased on / before the third week of the semester, but can be increased at any time.

Living Preferences



We have a couple questions we would like to ask before you select the buildings in which you are interested in living - we're almost there! Please read the information carefully so you know what you ARE or are NOT selecting as these responses will inform what options you see next.

Are you interested in a PRIVATE BEDROOM?

Students can request a private room in Blair-Shannon, Freddy, Hammons, Heitz, Hutchens, Scholars, Wells, or Woods. It is what we refer to as a **2-person private room**, meaning you would get a traditional 2-person room but completely to yourself. Is this something you want?

By checking the box, I would like to *request a private bedroom, understand that a private room is not guaranteed, and understand the following:*

- If I am assigned to a private room (based on availability):
 - The second set of furniture will remain in the room and is available for me to use.
 - The cost of a 2-person room private room is 1.5 times the rate of a 2-person room.
 - I understand that I will retain the room privately for the entire 2023-2024 academic year.

Do you need and/or want GENDER-INCLUSIVE HOUSING?

Gender-Inclusive Housing assists residents wishing to reside in housing where **gender** of roommates and suitemates is **NOT taken into consideration** when housing is assigned.

Gender-Inclusive Housing is intended to support all residents – especially those who are members of the LGBTQ+ community – who feel they would be more comfortable in a gender-inclusive room, as well as any resident who believes they could provide a welcoming and inclusive space for all gender identities.

To change your preferences your preferences at any time, return to the main housing application, and click on "update application preferences". This will allow you to go back through all of your application preferences to make any necessary changes.*

Additional Questions



You're almost done! We have a few last questions for you to answer to complete your application preferences.

What is your t-shirt size? *

The most important item on my housing application is the following: *

Roommate Preference - i.e. being assigned with my preferred roommate is more important than the LLCs or building/room type.

Building Preference - i.e. being assigned to my highest preferred building/room type is more important than the LLCs or preferred roommate.

LLC Preference - i.e. being assigned to an LLC is more important than the building/room type or preferred roommate.

I would like to be involved in Hall Council.

Each building has what is called a Hall Council. It is an organization similar to Student Council in high school and has a budget to spend on events, equipment, and other fun / educational things for your specific building.

I would like the Disability Resource Center (DRC) to contact me.

Meningitis Information



As a final reminder, you must have either an approved meningitis record or exemption on file before your application will be considered complete.

***Menactra and Menveo are the only two approved meningitis vaccines.**

Students who have already been vaccinated:

You must submit your medical records to the **Magers Health and Wellness Center** these need to be marked in compliance before your application will be complete. These records can be faxed to Magers Health and Wellness Center at 417-836-4133 or e-mailed to MagersMedicalRecords@MissouriState.edu.

Students wishing to file an exemption:

The medical and religious exemption process information can be found on [Magers Health and Wellness Center website](#).

Each student attending a public institution of higher education in the state of Missouri who lives in on-campus housing must receive the meningococcal vaccine within 5 years of enrollment unless they has a medical or religious exemption.

****Please do NOT email or fax your records to Residence Life. This may delay the processing of your application as records will have to be forwarded to Magers.**
