

Residence Life: Facilities and Operations Graduate Assistant

Position Summary

The graduate assistant (GA) serves as a member the professional staff that oversees the daily operations of the residence halls and on-campus apartment facilities, including maintenance and custodial services. The GA serves in a leading role with the department's sustainability efforts and assists in the oversight of the recycling program for the halls. The GA assists in the selection, training, and supervision of student staff members. This position also assists in the coordination of special events within Residence Life, such as Fall Move-In, House Calls, Energy Competition, RecycleMania, and Spring Move-Out.

- Plans and organizes special events
- Serves in an on-call rotation with some holiday coverage
