While the newly renovated
Blunt Hall (pictured) serves as the
main home of the College of
Natural and Applied Sciences
(CNAS), CNAS is actually housed
in six on-campus buildings, as
well as other facilities and
research centers around the area.



- Blunt Hall houses the CNAS Dean's office; the Biology Department; the Chemistry and Biochemistry Department; and the School of Earth, Environment and Sustainability.
- Cheek Hall is home to the Computer Science Department and the Mathematics Department.
- The Physics, Astronomy, and Materials Science Department is housed in Kemper Hall.
- The King's Street Annex also houses part of the Biology Department and the Herbarium.
- You'll find the Cooperative Engineering Program based in the Plaster Free Enterprise Center downtown.
