In 1987, staff members created a scholarship fund to recognize exceptional student leaders. The scholarship was first awarded in 1995 upon endowment of the fund. This was the same year that Wilda F. 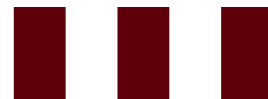
