1) You will first be directed to the main menu for the housing application, and you will see the following. Start your 2026-2027 housing application by clicking the "click here" button next to **Complete My Housing Application for 2026-2027**.

2) It starts with a brief welcome message and explanation of what it means to have a completed application.

Then, you'll see a **FINISH** button which means you've made it to the end!

You will be able to view your Application Summary to double-check that all items have been received and how to take action if any items are incomplete.






3) The application begins with you signing the terms and conditions. You will be emailed a copy of the full document after you click "I agree" at the bottom of the page.

You will receive Dining Dollars at the beginning of each the Fall and Spring semesters. Unused dining dollars from Fall 2026 will roll-over to Spring 2027, but any unused dining dollars at the end of Spring 2027 expire. Your meals-per-week meal plan package resets every Monday.

The most popular choices are the 14-meals-per-week plan and \$210 dining dollar package. Please note: meal plans may only be decreased on / before the third week of the semester, but can be increased at any time.



8) We have a lot of different types of rooms available and we have a couple questions that will help us know more about the specific types of living arrangements you need and/or are interested in.





### Are you interested in a PRIVATE BEDROOM?

Students can request a private bedroom in Blair-Shannon, Freddy, Hammons, Heitz, Hutchens, Scholars, Wells, or Woods. It is what we refer to as a **2-person private room**, meaning you would get a traditional 2-person room but completely to yourself. Is this something you want and are willing to pay for?

By checking the box, I would like to request a private bedroom, understand that a private room is not guaranteed, and understand the following:



- · If I am assigned to a private room (based on availability):
  - The second set of furniture will remain in the room and is available for me to use.
  - The cost of a 2-person room private room is 1.5 times the rate of that 2-person room.
  - o I understand that I will retain the room privately for the entire academic year.
  - The only option I will have to lower my housing cost will be to move to a shared room.
  - I understand I will not be able to break my housing contract on the basis of extreme financial need as I am requesting to increase my housing cost as outlined in the email I received.

### Do you need GENDER-INCLUSIVE HOUSING?

Gender-Inclusive Housing assists residents wishing to reside in housing where gender of roommates and suitemates is NOT taken into consideration when housing is assigned.

Gender-Inclusive Housing is intended to support all residents – especially those who are members of the LGBTQ+ community – who feel they would be more comfortable in a gender-inclusive room, as well as any resident who believes they could provide a welcoming and inclusive space for all gender identities.

Roommate Preference - i.e. being assigned with my preferred roommate is more important than the LLCs or building/room type.

Building Preference - i.e. being assigned to my highest preferenced building/room type is more important then the LLCs or roommate.

Each building has what is called a Hall Council. It is an organization similar to Student Council in high school and has a budget to spend on events, equipment, and other fun / educational things for your specific building.

#### Do you have any animal allergies?

The most important item on my housing

In some cases, a student with a disability may have a service or assistance animal reside with them in the residence hall. Students with significant animal allergies should register with the <u>Disability Resource Center</u> and request housing accommodations for their allergies.

Do you have a disability or medical condition that requires an accommodation in oncampus housing?

If so, please register with the <u>Disability Resource Center</u> which includes providing disability/medical documentation, meeting with an Access Advisor, and working with them to complete the Housing Access accommodation request process. All accommodation requests for Residence Halls must be made through the Disability Resource Center. MSU reviews requests for reasonable accommodation at any time, however, provision of the accommodation is best served when the request is <u>completed prior to housing assignments being released</u>.



11) We provide another reminder about the meningitis vaccination requirement. If you've already done what you need to do, simply click **NEXT STEP** and keep going!



As a final reminder, you must have either an approved meningitis record or exemption on file before your application will be considered complete.

Each student attending a public institution of higher education in the state of Missouri who lives in on-campus housing must receive the meningococcal vaccine within 5 years of enrollment unless they has a medical or religious exemption.

\*MenQuadfi, Menactra and Menveo are the only three approved meningitis vaccines.

### Students who have already been or will be vaccinated:

You must submit your medical records to **Magers Health and Wellness Center.** These need to be marked in compliance <u>before</u> your application will be complete. These records can be faxed to Magers Health and Wellness Center at 888-586-1348 or e-mailed to <a href="MagersMedicalRecords@MissouriState.edu">MagersMedicalRecords@MissouriState.edu</a>.

### Students wishing to file an exemption:

The medical and religious exemption process information can be found on <u>Magers Health and</u> Wellness Center website.

\*\*Please do NOT send your records to Residence Life. This may delay the processing of your application as records have to be forwarded to Magers.
